INTRODUCTION

The PPP Pipeline delivers essential information on Tanzania's Public-Private Partnership (PPP) projects to the public and key stakeholders. The PPP Centre, responsible for promoting and coordinating all aspects of PPP initiatives in the country, is dedicated to showcasing the development projects that will be executed under PPP arrangements. This initiative emphasizes our commitment to transparency and effective collaboration in enhancing the nation's infrastructure and services.

The Tanzania PPP Projects pipeline includes ongoing initiatives across various sectors, including transport, public works, energy, health, defense and security, sports, water, agriculture, fisheries, education, and local government authorities. These projects cover a wide range of infrastructure and services, such as the construction of highways, railways, ports, commercial buildings, and solar power plants. They also encompass cancer control services, rural water supply schemes, motor vehicle inspection centers, hotels, student hostels, solid waste management facilities, bus terminals, and market development.
