INTRODUCTION

Public–Private Partnerships (PPPs) are commonly used as an effective way to attract private sector investment in infrastructure and improve public services. Through PPP agreements, governments can leverage private sector funding, innovation, and technical skills while still overseeing policies, regulations, and public service management.

In Tanzania, the implementation of **PPP projects is guided by the Public–Private Partnership Act (Cap. 103) and its supporting regulations**, which establish the legal and institutional framework for identifying, preparing, procurement, and managing PPP projects. The Public–Private Partnership Centre (PPP Centre) is responsible for coordinating and promoting PPP initiatives and supporting contracting authorities in the preparation and execution of PPP projects across various sectors economy.

The significance of PPPs has been further reinforced in the **Fourth Five-Year Development Plan (FYDP IV)** and the long-term goals of the **Tanzania Development Vision 2050**. Implementing FYDP IV is projected to require **around TZS 477 trillion in investment**, with the **private sector expected to contribute approximately TZS 334 trillion**. Much of this investment is anticipated to be mobilized through PPP arrangements, underscoring the importance of a strong pipeline of well-prepared and bankable PPP projects.

To support this goal, the **PPP Centre regularly compiles the national PPP Projects Pipeline** to provide information on projects that are being prepared or considered for implementation under PPP arrangements. The pipeline acts as a key planning and information resource for government agencies, development partners, investors, and other stakeholders by showcasing projects at various stages of development, including concept, pre-feasibility, feasibility, procurement, negotiation, and beyond implementation.

The Tanzania PPP Projects Pipeline presented in this document includes projects across several sectors such as transport, energy, water, trade and logistics infrastructure, education, health, fisheries, urban development, and local government infrastructure. By publishing this pipeline, the Government aims to enhance transparency, promote private sector participation, and accelerate the implementation of infrastructure projects that support sustainable economic growth and improved public service delivery in Tanzania.
